**Presentation Title:** **Brain Injury: Tales from Rehab**

**Abstract:** The treatment of acquired brain injury is fast becoming the largest area of growth in the field of optometry. While optometry was once relegated to the sidelines, we are now part of the treatment team, seeing patients both in the rehabilitation facility and in our offices. The care of these patients when in the rehabilitation facility is aimed at stabilization and augmenting the care provided by other rehabilitation team members. Treatments provided include binasal and spot occlusion, refractive care, anterior and posterior segment health care, and rehabilitative activities. Perhaps the most important aspect of being part of the care team is the ability to provide information regarding the patient to the other team members for the benefit of the care process. Cases seen at the rehabilitation facilities will be highlighted in this case-based presentation.
